Kiangsu-Chekiang College was founded by Kiangsu Chekiang and Shanghai Residents (HK) Association in 1958 and became a Direct Subsidy School in 1993.

Our School :

- offers holistic education and has developed a tradition of excellence in teaching and learning;
- emphasizes bilingual education (English and Chinese). We offer both English class and Chinese class in each secondary level. Chinese Language and Chinese History in junior forms are taught in Putonghua;
- provides WiFi network in the whole school to enhance e-learning;
- offers 38 extra-curricular activities to challenge students intellectually, physically and artistically;
- provides a wide range of special and functional rooms: Language Laboratory, Audio-Visual Language Centre, Multi-media Learning Centre, Computer Rooms and KCC Campus TV Station to enhance teaching and learning practices;
- offers computing facilities in the Library where 40,000 books and publications are stored. Our Library can accommodate more than 200 students;
- offers 400 seats in the School Canteen (junior form students ought to stay in school for lunch);
- offers air-conditioned classrooms and special rooms;
- offers scholarships and tuition fee remission, other than the Government-run Textbook and Travel Subsidy Schemes. In the academic year 2017-2018, the total amount of remission offered was \$ 296,411 (12.7 % of total tuition fees). Parents may visit our school website or call us at 29693939 for more information;
- offers International Baccalaureate course in our International Section. Interested students in F.4 could apply for the one-year Preparatory Course and start the two-year course in Year 12;
- provides an integration programme with our International Section for students to experience academic diversity;
- joined the study tour to Ningbo, which was organized by the International Ningbo Merchants Association during Easter Holidays in 2018 and a cultural visit to our sister school Jiaying No.1 High School in May, 2018;
- organized an educational study tour to Finland in summer holidays in 2018, students explored the Finnish culture. Also, different cultural study tours to Sichuan and Beijing were held during summer in 2018.
- has arranged visits to the Mainland for Non-Chinese students to learn more about Chinese culture.

Notes to applicants : (Number of discretionary places is 30 in school year 2019/2020.)

1. P.6 students can apply for Form 1 Discretionary Places. Application forms can be obtained at the Registry.
2. Completed forms with copies of transcripts in P.5 and P.6 (First Term) should be submitted to the School from 3rd to 17th January, 2019. (Recommendation letter from Primary school is not needed)
3. Interview will be held at 2nd March, 2019 (Saturday), all applicants would be informed by mail.
4. Criteria of admission are as follows:
Rank Order List from EDB (25%), Conduct and Teachers' Comments (25%), Academic Results in P.5 and P.6(1st term) (20%), Interviews (10%), Extra-curricular activities (10%), Awards (5%) and School and Social Service (5%).
